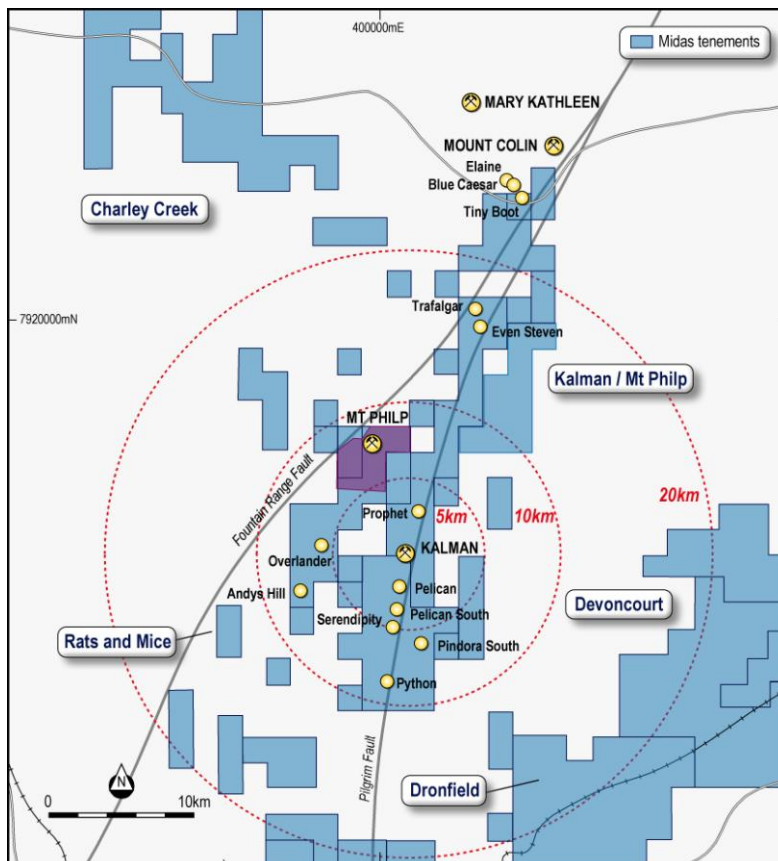
HAMMER TO RE-COMMENCE DRILLING

Hammer Metals Limited ("Hammer" "the Company") (ASX: MDSA) announces that a new drilling program of approximately 2000 metres of RC and diamond drilling is due to commence in mid-April.

The program will complete field work that commenced in December 2013 and which resulted in a new Mineral Resource at the Overlander North copper deposit. (Refer to ASX release dated March 31 2014).

Weather permitting drilling will start at Overlander and then move on to test the Pelican and Serendipity prospects south of Hammer's Kalman copper-gold-molybdenum-rhenium deposit. A short diamond drilling program is also planned at Overlander to obtain core samples for preliminary metallurgical test work.

The program is designed to pursue Hammer's strategy of defining high grade copper resources within trucking distance of Kalman.
